

UPDATE on protections for renters during COVID-19

The State of Oregon has created new rules to protect renters from losing their homes during the pandemic.

To be protected, you MUST turn in the attached form to your landlord.

These protections apply until June 30th, 2021, if you qualify:

- Landlords can't evict tenants, or even threaten to evict, for not paying rent, utilities, and fees.
- Landlords can't charge any late fees if tenants can't pay rent during this time.
- All unpaid rent is due July 1, 2021.

Tenants qualify for these protections if <u>any</u> of the following are true since March 16, 2020:

- Loss of household income, work or wages
- Increased <u>expenses</u> for medical care, childcare, or caring for a person who is disabled, sick, injured or elderly
- Increased <u>responsibilities</u> of childcare or caring for a person with a disability or that is sick, injured, or elderly
- Reduced income or increased expenses due to other circumstances

If one or more of these circumstances apply to you, <u>you must submit the</u> <u>attached form to your landlord</u> in order to be protected from eviction.

If you do not qualify:

- Rent is due as normal, beginning from January 1, 2021, and landlords could give an eviction notice for non-payment of rent, utilities, and fees. Late fees are allowed
- Any unpaid rent from October 1 December 31, 2020 is due March 31, 2021.
- A 10-day notice for non-payment evictions is required (increased from 72 hours).
- If you get an eviction notice, you can still submit a declaration letter to your landlord up until your first appearance at court.
